

Custodial Parent Request to Continue Collecting Spousal Support

Pursuant to Utah Code 26B-9-114(1), "An obligee may request that the office continue to collect spousal support on behalf of the obligee if: (a) the office has been collecting spousal support for the obligee as a part of child support; and (b) the office is no longer collecting child support for the obligee and has closed the case related to the child support."

The Office of Recovery Services (ORS) may only continue to collect and enforce current and past-due spousal support (alimony) if requested by you. If you do not request ORS to continue to collect and enforce spousal support, ORS will end the spousal support debt with the termination of child support.

According to ORS records, the child support collection of your case will be ending soon. If ORS is currently collecting spousal support on your behalf, and you would like ORS to continue collecting spousal support, please sign, date, and return this form within 30 days from the date of the letter ORS sent regarding your child support case closing for continuing spousal support collection. If ORS does not receive your written request to continue collecting spousal support, the case will be closed when the child support collection ends. Please select **ONE** of the options below:
