

**Noncustodial Parent's Evidence or Information that Spousal Support is No Longer Enforceable**

State law found in Utah Code 26B-9-114 allows ORS to continue to collect spousal support after child support collection has ended until the spousal support is no longer enforceable.

If you believe spousal support is no longer enforceable, please list any evidence or information below [e.g., a court order, emancipation, cohabits as defined in Utah Code 81-4-501(2), remarriage, etc.]. Then send the evidence and this form to ORS. Please note that if the other parent denies cohabitation, ORS will not make a cohabitation decision. ORS will continue to collect spousal support until ORS is provided with a court-ordered end date. You may seek legal advice and/or take further action in court to obtain a court-ordered end date.
